2. All proposals for undergraduate independent study must be signed by the supervising faculty and submitted to the department for approval; forms are available from the Department of Architecture Undergraduate Advisor.
3. Students may not apply to both CARC study abroad courses and ENDS and ARTS courses with similar content to their degree plan.
4. A grade of "C" or better must be made in all College of Architecture courses (ARCH, ARTS, CARC, COSC, ENDS, LAND, LDEV, URPN and VIST). Students must also make a "C" or better in any course used as an equivalent substitution for College of Architecture course satisfying degree requirements.
