The Center for Heritage Conservation at Texas A&M University supports research on the planning and preservation of built environments, with a particular focus on their continued use and care. We specialize in cultural heritage, heritage conservation, and historic preservation. Additionally, the CHC promotes research on landscapes and cultural landscapes, employing preservation and resilience-based approaches to foster integrated management. Our investigations are conducted through sponsored projects, as well as professional and academic studies.

Featured works include digital images documenting the scanning and preservation of historic buildings both in the U.S. and internationally (e.g., Italy, Belize).
